

New speeding fines are due to come into effect as part of a crackdown to improve road safety.

From 24th April 2017 drivers who are taken to court for speeding could be fined up to 150% of their weekly income, with a limit of £1,000 for roads and £2,500 if the offence was committed on a motorway.

The new fines will impact anyone caught speeding at more than 100mph on motorways, as well as drivers speeding significantly above standard limits in villages, towns and cities.

Driving at more than 41mph in a 20mph zone will also fall under the new sentences, as will getting caught speeding at more than 51 mph in a 30mph zone.
