

Vehicle Excise Duty changes

Important information



The Government is making significant changes to Vehicle Excise Duty Rates (VED) for cars registered on or after 1st April 2017. This means that nearly all cars registered on or after 1st April 2017 will see a change in the amount of RFL they need to pay.

To reflect the new VED rates, LeasePlan updated our Quotes and Order systems on Friday 13th January to ensure that any new quotes produced from that date include the new VED rates.

As lead times do vary by manufacturer, our intention was to minimise any price changes required for vehicles that would be delivered post 1st April.

How does this affect you?

- Orders placed before 13th January for vehicles which will be registered before 1st April are not impacted.
- Orders placed after 13th January for vehicles which will be registered after 1st April will be quoted correctly, at the new VED rate.
- The new RFL scheme excludes vans.

Some orders will be affected, and the actions LeasePlan will take are detailed below:

- Any orders placed before the 13th of January but due to be delivered after the 1st of April we will need to update with the new VED Rates. Our Customer Service Teams will contact you to provide you with the updated rental to reflect the new VED amount.
- Any orders placed after the 13th of January and therefore including the new higher rates but due to be delivered before the 1st of April we will proactively Schedule Update upon delivery to reflect the lower costs.
